A Tobolsk, the centre of the development of Siberia founded in 1587, is a city with a population of about 100 thousand people located in the north of the Tyumen region, at the confluence of the Tobol and Irtysh rivers. Today, Tobolsk is one of the most important centres of educational tourism in Siberia and a major industrial centre of Russia in the field of gas chemistry international problems.

B There is more than one way to capture and use solar energy, but residential homes can use solar panels. The sun shines on them, creating direct current electricity. This DC electricity feeds into a device that converts it in to AC (alternating current) electricity, which can power appliances in the home. Your home would still connect to the traditional power grid to have electricity at night.

C Dmitri Mendeleev was born in Tobolsk, Russia, on February 8, 1834. After receiving an education in science in Russia and Germany, he became a professor and conducted research in chemistry. Mendeleev is best known for his discovery of the periodic law, which he introduced in 1869, and for his formulation of the periodic table of elements.

D The Monument to Dmitri Mendeleev was installed in St. Petersburg on the territory of the square of the Main Chamber. The monument to Mendeleev is a large-scale figure: the scientist is sitting in a luxurious armchair in a unique position, putting one foot on the other and looking thoughtfully into the distance. The whole sculpture was cast from bronze in 1938.

E Saint Petersburg can be reached in 4 hours via the high-speed Sapsan trains from Moscow. Fares vary and are cheaper if bought well in advance. There are also about 15 overnight trains that travel between Moscow and Saint Petersburg. These overnight trains are generally cheaper than the Sapsan, including modern and well-equipped two-storey trains.

School in the Slums (в трущобах).

Mellish school is in the slums of Brooklyn for pupils between twelve and fifteen years of age. There are about 1500 pupils there, and 90 teachers. It's a problem school, perhaps one of the most difficult schools in America. The white teachers can't walk to the school because they may be attacked. They all drive to school, and their cars have special locks. There's always a black policeman at the door of the school. He has a radio contact with the school guards. Pupils must have a written permission from the teacher if they want to go to the toilet. There's a guard outside the washroom. Only one child can go into the washroom at a time, and he can't stay there long. The children who live in that district go to that school. They are all black children. However, why do the teachers work there? "It's very hard of course," says Jane Flinch, a forty-five-year-old teacher. Most children have problems at home. Some of them are beaten by their parents. Some of them sleep at the lessons because they had to work at night. Some of the children get sick at the lessons because they didn't have breakfast or even a meal for a day or two. It's the love of the job that keeps the teachers in that school. They teach and do social work. They feel that they are doing something good for the children who need help. "There's also the problem of violence," says one of the teachers. "Sometimes when I go into a class, I can feel that some of the children are like a dynamite. However, I feel quite safe. I am sure that other pupils will help me." There is very little money for teaching in that school. There is no money to buy food for the children. The principal of the school has been there for many years. A lot of his happy optimism has gone. "No, I'm not optimistic about the future. Look around you," he says and points out of the window at the high wall round the school. "It's not a very bright sight: buildings have holes instead of the windows, shops are closed, groups of people are sitting on the steps of the houses. They have nowhere to go and nothing to do." "We need money," he says, "money is the only way to help this school and these people, and, of course, jobs for the people.
